



## CTAP Region 10 DataTrek<sup>®</sup> Workshop

*A customized database tool for the collection, analysis,  
and reporting of classroom observations*

This workshop integrates handheld technology tools with a short classroom observation protocol and database. Using the CTAP Region 10 DataTrek<sup>®</sup> database, participants will have hands-on experience reviewing classroom observation protocols, practice collecting classroom observation data on a handheld computer, and analyze the data collected to generate reports.

### Customized Database

CTAP Region 10 DataTrek<sup>®</sup> is a customizable database that is designed to collect information about areas of curricular focus and the strategies used to teach the curriculum. A few sample fields in the database include:

- Percent of Students on Task
- Lesson Objective (Standards)
- Depth of Knowledge
- Effective Practices
- Instructional Mode
- Teacher Activity
- Checking For Understanding
- Classroom Environment

### Workshop Details

- Workshops are customized based on district needs
- Prerequisites: A handheld computer, FileMaker Pro<sup>™</sup> 7.0, and FileMaker Mobile<sup>™</sup> 7.0 software
- Six-hour workshop format
- \$250 per participant (minimum 10, maximum 20)
- Workshop fees include the initial meeting to identify district-based data fields, customization of the database, the CTAP Region 10 DataTrek<sup>®</sup> workshop and a follow-up meeting.
